

Assimilation must be proven at the time of admission and confirmed at the time of enrolment (i.e. all documents proving assimilation must be submitted) no later than October 31 of the relevant academic year.

<p>1. Benefit from a long-term residence permit in Belgium</p> <p>(student or father/mother/legal guardian or spouse/legal cohabitant)</p>	<p>A copy of both sides of the identity card proving the long-term residence in Belgium of the person concerned* (e B,C,D,E, E+, F,F+,K,L,M,S,Pcard)</p> <p>To note: the one-year renewable A card is not a long-term residence permit</p>

Benefit from a refugee status or be a refugee candidate, stateless person or temporary subsidiary protection</p> <p>(student or father/mother/legal guardian or spouse/legal cohabitant)</p>	<p>Refugee: A copy of both sides of the B-card of the person concerned*</p> <p>Stateless person: Official document from the municipality or the Foreigners' Office proving the stateless status of the person concerned*</p> <p>Subsidiary or temporary protection: Certificate of registration in the register of foreigners for a limited period of one year, renewable (A or B card) + Decision of the Foreigner's Office attesting to the subsidiary or temporary protection of the person concerned*</p> <p>Refugee candidate: An orange card issued by the municipality of residence and valid at the time of submission; A copy of the order to leave the territory (annex 26bis) OR Document attesting that the asylum application has not been definitively rejected (annex 26) of the person concerned* + lawyer's letter dated the month of registration stating that the appeal is still open</p>

Be authorised to reside in Belgium for more than three months and exercise a real and effective professional activity or receive replacement income</p> <p>(student or father/mother/legal guardian or spouse/legal cohabitant)</p>	<p>A copy of both sides of the residence permit of more than 3 months (A card or registration certificate (orange card)) of the person concerned* +</p> <p>Professional activity: recent employment certificate mentioning the salary OR employment contract + 6 pay slips (the minimum amount of which corresponds or has corresponded over 6 of the 12 months preceding registration to half of the minimum guaranteed average monthly remuneration set by the "Conseil national du Travail") of the person concerned*</p> <p>Replacement income: certificate of replacement income (CPAS(uniquement RIS-), unemployment, mutual insurance company, pension) of the person concerned*, dated the month of registration</p>

4. Reside in a home from the CPAS (student or father/mother/legal guardian or spouse/legal cohabitant)	A copy of both sides of the residence permit of more than 3 months (card A or registration certificate (orange card)) of the person concerned* + certificate of placement in a home from the CPAS, dated the month of registration
5. Father/mother/legal guardian or spouse/legal cohabitant of EU Member State nationality	A copy of the national identity card of the person concerned*.
6. Scholarship student	Certificate of proof of a belgian scholarship (CFWB-CDVLP)
7. Student authorised to stay in Belgium for more than three months on the basis of long-term resident status acquired in another EU Member State	A copy of both sides of the residence permit of more than 3 months (card A or registration certificate (orange card)) + document attesting the long term resident status obtained in another European Union Member State

In order to prove the family relationship with the person concerned by the assimilation criterion, please also provide the following documents:

- * **Father/mother:** a household composition if living at the same place as the student **OR** a birth certificate
- * **Legal guardian:** a guardianship act transcribed in Belgian law (*please do not confuse legal guardian with financial guardian with financial support*)
- * **Spouse:** a household composition if living at the same place as the student + a marriage certificate
 - if European marriage: a European marriage certificate
 - if non-European marriage: a marriage certificate legalised by a Belgian embassy or consulate and transcribed under Belgian law.
- * **Legal cohabitant:** a legal cohabitation certificate
